All participants who have presented a talk or poster at the conference are kindly invited to publish their work by submitting it as a paper to a special issue in the **Journal of Materials Science: Materials in Electronics** (SpringerNature), which is a well-established journal with a long track record in excellence and an Impact Factor of 2.8 (2022). The journal information is under the link https://link.springer.com/journal/10854.

The submission will *open* after the conference to allow authors to include suggestions that have received during the conference. It is important to consider any critique received on the presentation and to address these in the paper. Tentative date is: **15 July 2024**

The special issue is exclusive for papers that have actually been presented (invited, contributed oral, poster) at the conference. Papers that have not been presented will be returned.

The special issue will also allow reviews to be submitted. Reviews must be complete reviews in a given materials system, rather than short surveys and written by experts in the field.

There are no restrictions in length for the contributions. For the formatting of the paper, we refer to the Journal's webpage. All topics covered by the conference are suitable. However, the **Journal of Materials Science: Materials in Electronics** rarely publishes purely theoretical or computational papers. Authors who wish to submit mainly computational or theoretical work, are advised to make a clear link to *experimental* findings.

During the submission process, under the TAB "Additional Information", you will be asked whether the paper is for a special issue. Answer "Yes" and choose "S.I.: ICOOPMA2024" from the list of special issues for which the submission is open.
